
## Trap, Tackle, Tees

The retreat features a number of activities on Saturday designed to allow men time to enjoy time together in God's creation. Our activities include a scramble golf tournament at Hannibal's Norwood Golf Club, a fishing tournament at Mark Twain Lake and other neighboring lakes, a trap and skeet shooting tournament at a local gun club (hence our name T-3 for Trap-Tackle-Tees). You can bring your bike and explore on your own, hike in the beautiful woods if or just spend Saturday morning relaxing or reading. Missouri State Park will also offer some special offerings this year including archery and other topics. There is something for everyone.

# About the Retreat

## Information and Registration

The cost of the retreat remains \$45 for registration. This includes all meals and sleeping arrangements on the camp grounds, as well as a commemorative gift. The group camp has room for approximately 80 in cabins and we have space for tent campers, too. In addition, some choose to stay in local motels for additional comfort. For example, the Dry Dock Motel is about five miles from the camp and has twelve motel rooms and seven extra bedrooms. The cost is about \$20-25 per person per night. (Dry Dock Motel's phone number is 1 573 560-0084. You must make your own reservations if want to use this facility). We are continuing our "Thursday Option" for some who have asked to arrive on Thursday afternoon, spend the night, and enjoy a full day on Friday. Those who choose this option will pay an additional \$15 to cover food on Thursday night and Friday's breakfast and lunch along with an extra night's lodging.

Participants pay for their choice of recreational activities. The golf tournament is \$35. Those who choose the shooting tournament must pay for shells and clay targets. Fishermen must have a Missouri fishing license and some rent boats or pair up with those who bring boats. Horseshoes, hiking, nature tour and individual activities like biking, reading and sleeping are free. There will be no charge for the Mark Twain State Park instructional activities on Saturday afternoon from 2-3:30 pm.
